

CURRICULUM

Out of the 'box' this program is designed to be four :60-:90 minute Pilot lessons with three teacher led lessons in-between. However this program is about you and your class - work with your teacher to see what is best for them and feel free to modify it to fit your needs.



YOUR VISITS

It is important you and your teacher have a shared 'vision'. Some things to think about:

- How often should you visit (once a week, once a month, etc.)
- Special needs for the class or any student.
- Do they want to participate in the Adopt-A-Pilot Tie Contest?
- Are they going to do the 'A' Lessons?
- Classroom logistics (how to play videos, connect to the internet, signals to get the class to quiet down, etc.)
